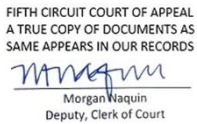

IN RE CHEZ EVERETTE

APPLYING FOR SUPERVISORY WRIT FROM THE TWENTY-FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT, PARISH OF JEFFERSON, STATE OF LOUISIANA, DIRECTED TO THE HONORABLE STEPHEN D. ENRIGHT, JR., DIVISION "N", NUMBER 24-4307

WRIT DENIED

Relator, Chez Everette, appearing herein *pro se*, seeks this Court's supervisory review of the district court's March 20, 2025 ruling denying his motion to suppress evidence. For the reasons that follow, on the showing made, we deny the writ application.

According to the record, on February 18, 2025, Mr. Everette filed a motion to suppress evidence allegedly illegally obtained pursuant to a warrantless search of a vehicle in which Mr. Everette was a passenger. The record indicates that Mr. Everette's motion to suppress was heard by the district court on March 20, 2025, and was denied. This writ application seeking review of that ruling followed.

As an initial matter, we note that Mr. Everette's writ application is deficient in that it does not include an index of attachments, a list of the assignments of error, a copy of the district court's March 20, 2025 ruling, a copy of each pleading on which the ruling was founded, or a copy of pertinent court minutes, as required

by Uniform Rules–Courts of Appeal, Rule 4–5(C). Additionally, Mr. Everette has failed to include a notice of intent requesting a return date or an order from the trial court setting a return date for him to file this writ application. *See* Uniform Rules–Courts of Appeal, Rules 4–2, 4–3, and 4–5(C).¹

Considering that Mr. Everette’s writ application is deficient, we have no basis upon which to grant Mr. Everette the relief he seeks. Accordingly, on the showing made, Mr. Everette’s writ application is denied.
