**WRIT DENIED**

Relator/defendant, Colonial Oaks Care Center of Metairie, LLC  
d/b/a Colonial Oaks Living Center seeks review of the trial court's  
January 20, 2026 judgment granting respondent/plaintiff's motion to  
compel discovery in regard to requests for production of documents  
numbers eight and sixteen.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Relator does not challenge the trial court's judgment which also granted plaintiff's motion to compel in regard to request for production of documents number 23.

In ruling on discovery matters, the trial court is vested with broad discretion, and an appellate court should not disturb such rulings absent a clear abuse of discretion. Khoobehi Props., LLC v. Baronne Dev. No. 2, L.L.C., 16-506 (La. App. 5 Cir. 3/29/17), 216 So.3d 287, 303, writ denied, 17-893 (La. 9/29/17), 227 So.3d 288.

Upon a thorough review of the writ application, exhibits attached thereto, and the January 8, 2026 transcript of the motion to compel hearing, on the showing made, we find no clear abuse of discretion by the trial court, or a sufficient basis upon which to disturb the trial court's ruling. Accordingly, this writ application is denied.
