WRIT DENIED

Relators, Marc G. Barbé and Renata E. Barbé, appearing *pro se*, seek supervisory review of the 24th Judicial District Court's January 22, 2026 ruling to grant Respondent's, US Bank National Association ["the Bank"] Not in its Individual Capacity but Solely as Trustee of the NRZ Pass-Through Trust XVI, *Ex Parte* Motion to Withdraw and Substitute Counsel, and its January 28, 2026 ruling granting the Bank's Motion to Continue and Reset Hearing.

On the showing made, we find the district court did not err or abuse its discretion in granting the Bank's motion to continue or denying Relator's motions to strike the motion to continue. "A trial court has vast discretion in controlling its

docket and in determining whether motions to continue should be granted.”

Succession of Feingerts, 17-265, p. 3 (La. App. 4 Cir. 12/21/17), 234 So.3d 1081, 1085, *writ denied*, 18-0147 (La. 3/23/18), 239 So.3d 297. Also, as the trial court stated in its Reasons for Judgment, the only matter before the court at the January 28, 2026 hearing was the Bank’s Motion to Continue and Reset Hearing; the hearing on Relators’ Motion to Vacate Order on Motion to Withdraw and Substitute Counsel was set for a later date. Further, the assignments of error above concern the merits of Relators’ pending urged exceptions and motion for summary judgment.

Accordingly, the writ is denied.
